The compact, super-durable aluminum die cast enclosure is 2/3 the size of most volume pedals – perfect for smaller boards and travel rigs.

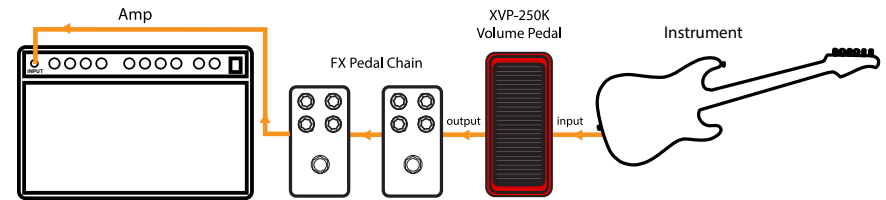

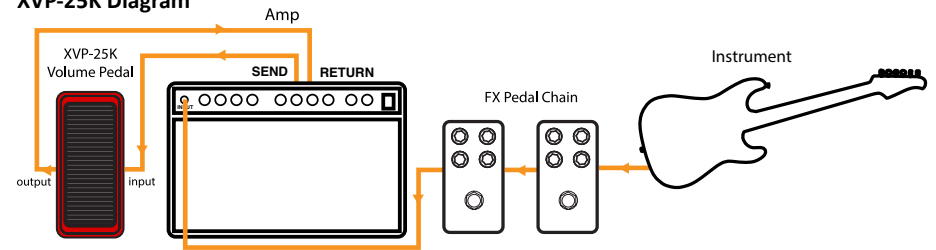
